## Week of the Young Child 2021: April 4-8

Fremont Christian Early Education joins in the nationally recognized *Week of the Young Child* celebration endorsed by The National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC).

This celebration is intended to spotlight the importance of a solid foundation in early childhood education in the first five years of life. Research has reported that 90% of the human brain is developed by age five, and over 700 synapses are generated every second in the early years of life developing the pathways of the brain used for learning.

**Science Foundations** are the emphasis for this year's curriculum focus. Each classroom has selected a topic from Earth, Life, or Physical Science, and will use scientific inquiry to explore, investigate, observe, data collect, and draw conclusions about each area of study. The overarching theme connecting all classroom's investigations is our biblical truth found in Psalm 139:14.

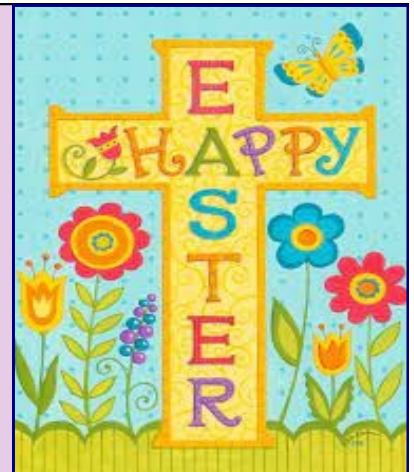
July 1 will also be the beginning of our Summer Curriculum.
