### Social Emotional Development:

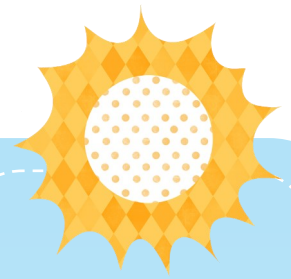
Social Emotional foundations in early learning provide children with the skills that scaffold later high functioning learning. Teachers here at Fremont Christian Preschool intentionally promote, plan, and teach children the critical skills that will enable them to be effective learners as they grow here at Fremont Christian.



The first step in making every child successful in a school environment is to establish warm and responsive relationships with teachers and peers. Relationships provide children a sense of belonging, safety and security, as well as a safe environment to explore.

As relationships become established, children begin to learn how their identity to themselves impacts the world around them. Through this learning children gain skills in expressions of empathy, impulse control, turn taking, cooperation, conflict negotiation, as well as sharing. All of these skills are directly related to problem solving which is a foundational concept for later math and science learning.

Social Emotional Development is an emphasis for curriculum planning in August and September.
