#### **Hot Days are Here!**

Let's prepare together for Hot Days at School.

- Classroom temperatures will be maintained at a temperature of 68°F-72°F daily.
- Parents apply morning sunscreen. Teachers will re-apply before afternoon outdoor time at 3

#### 2023 Transition Plan

All children's placements for the 2023-2024 preschool year will be made at the beginning of June. We are beginning our annual transition plan to ensure a smooth and thoughtful transition for children moving to a new classroom. Here are some ways FCS Staff support children in this annual movement:
