What is Priority Re-Enrollment?

Re-Enrollment is a period of time at FCS where families are to complete annual documents that indicate a desire to return for the following school year. The Preschool Office uses this information to begin to build next school year's classroom placements that begin on July 1, 2022. All documents are due by March 1st for Preschool and mid-March for TK and Kindergarten.

- Please make sure to submit your 2022-2023 online re-registration.
- You will need to review the 2022-2023 Fee Schedule and Parent Handbook.
- Turn in the hard copy Admissions Agreement, Parent Handbook receipt and Walking Permission Slip to the Preschool Office to guarantee placement for the 2022-2023 school year.

Growth Assessment Spring 2022

Assessment in early education is a cycle. Teachers at FCS first assess children between July and October, gather data through work samples, photos, and written observations of each child's accomplishments related to specific measures of development that track school readiness. The first assessment provides baseline information that directs the teacher's curriculum.



Parent Teacher Conferences are by appointment only between March 21-25.

The growth assessment is the second assessment in the school year, and data collected between October and February is used to complete the tool, and provides parents and teachers with each child's growth since the first assessment. This assessment is used to develop goals between March and the end of the school year, as well as one tool that is used to make determinations for "successful completion" of FCS Preschool for all of our Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten eligible students who plan on continuing to FCS next school year.

Everyone is welcome to request a Parent-Teacher conference to review your child's assessment with their teacher or just to check-in and see how things are going. Please email your teacher to schedule an appointment if you are interested.
