2023-2024 School Year Preschool Re-enrollment and TK/Kinder Enrollment



Current School Year Ends Thursday, June 29, 2023

Beginning and End of Year Dates: FCS Preschool is a full year program; however, we do have a beginning of the year and an end of the year. Thursday, June 29 is the last day of the 2022-2023 year, and all children that are eligible to apply for Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten will age out on that day. Please note that our Preschool Promotion to celebrate these two groups will be on Friday, June 23. We are closed for professional development on June 30, and on July 4 to observe Independence Day. Monday, July 3 is the first day of the 2023-2024 year for all returning preschool students.

What is FCS Preschool Re-Enrollment? In order to guarantee placement in the 2023-2024 preschool school year, which begins July 3, 2023, all currently enrolled families must complete re-enrollment. You will receive an email from FCS in mid-February that will prompt you to complete the online re-enrollment through FACTS. Please do not delay. Re-enrollment is due March 1.

After FCS receives your re-enrollment, your updated Admissions Agreement for 2023-2024, and your child's March parent conference is complete, we will inform you of your child's placement for the 2023-2024 school year. Your child's new classroom placement begins on July 3. Classroom placement letters are sent out in the first week of June. **(Please see the attached Early Education Program to understand how students advance through the FCS program.)**

How do I enroll in FCS Transitional Kindergarten? FCS Transitional Kindergarten is specifically for children turning five between September 2, 2023– April 2, 2024. Eligible FCS preschool students have first priority for the limited spaces available. Students eligible for TK will receive a re-enrollment notice in mid-March with a due date 5 days from the date of the email. Please refer to the tuition and fees schedule to understand all fees that will be due at the time of re-enrollment. Tuition and fees schedules will be available at fremontchristian.com in February.

How do I enroll in FCS Kindergarten? Children who are five years old before September 2, 2023 are eligible for FCS Kindergarten. Eligible FCS Preschool and TK students have first priority for the limited spaces available. Students eligible for Kindergarten will receive a re-enrollment notice in mid-March with a due date 5 days from the date of the email.

Please refer to the tuition and fees schedule to understand all fees that will be due at the time of reenrollment. Tuition and fees schedules will be available at fremontchristian.com in February. *Please follow the prompts on the reenrollment email to ensure enrollment and/or to ensure guidance regarding conditional enrollment terms.*



An Important Note Regarding Daily Sign In and Out— Please remember that it is important for your child to arrive at school on time. Check in is between 8:00 and 9:00 AM, anything after 9:00 is considered late. A \$10 late fee will be charged for all unexcused tardies and excessive tardiness may lead to disciplinary action. Community Care Licensing requires a parent or designated guardian ONLY to sign your child in or out of school. Please do not allow your children to touch the sign in IPADS.
