Hot Weather at FCS

Warm weather is upon us, and it's a great time for a reminder of how FCS manages warm days, and how we partner with families for the children's sun safety.

Community Care Licensing does not provide a "too hot to be outside" measure, and we rely on best practice measures to make determinations for staying indoors in extreme heat. We begin to monitor children's behavior and levels of play for "too hot" indications, and will also monitor the weather report. If we know it's going to be an extreme day, we will also adjust outdoor play times to accommodate cooler outdoor play.

How can parents partner with us?

- Dress Appropriately:** Make sure your child is wearing appropriate clothing, and layers for colder mornings with anticipated warmer afternoons. **Hats and Sunglasses** are welcome, but FCS Staff can't keep track of all outdoor pieces. Make sure to put your child's name on all belongings, and remember that FCS is not responsible for lost or broken items.
- Sunscreen:** All parents are asked to apply the morning sunscreen before drop-off. FCS Staff will reapply before the afternoon playtime. Make sure to have a bottle of sunscreen for the classroom. Sunscreen permission slips are in the preschool office.
- Hydrate:** Children have access to drinking water all day at FCS. Teachers also provide "water breaks" after outdoor play times. Children are more likely to drink from their own water bottle.
