#### New Student Fees

<b>Application Fee</b> (non-refundable*)	<b>\$500</b>	One-time fee for new students paid online at the time of application
<b>Registration Fee</b> (non-refundable*)	<b>\$550</b>	Due and payable within five (5) business days of acceptance. Must be paid before an I-20 will be issued. Includes the technology fee.
<b>Transcript Evaluation Fee</b>	<b>\$300</b>	Required for any high school student who begins at FCS after their first semester of 9th grade. FCS will have foreign transcripts evaluated based on the guidelines of the U.S. National Council for the Evaluation of Foreign Educational Credentials. Evaluated transcripts will be used for class ranking, school awards, and college admissions.  Families will receive an official copy and instructions on how to obtain additional copies.
<b>High School Retreat</b>	<b>\$375</b>	Grades 9–12 only
<b>Annual Tuition</b> (non-refundable*)	<b>\$33,700</b>	Due within five (5) working days of acceptance. For new students, full tuition is due before an I-20 will be issued.  Fee includes textbooks, international college advising, medical insurance, most on-campus testing.
<b>Homestay</b>	<b>\$25,000</b>	Due by May 1, or with tuition if acceptance is after May 1.  Host families are available only to students 14 years or older. Junior high students may live with an approved family member. Elementary school students are required to live with at least one parent. All homestay applicants must complete an FCS Homestay Student Application and an FCS Homestay Permission for Care and Release form.  Fee includes room and board, and transportation to and from all school events.
<b>Additional Fees</b>		Uniforms, classroom supplies, some school activities, clubs, teams, photos, and yearbooks may require additional fees.

\*Non-refundable means that Fremont Christian will not refund any amounts paid even if your family member does not ultimately enroll in a program, does not complete enrollment, attend a program, withdraws from a program, or otherwise. Non-refundable also means all amounts paid are non-transferable; therefore, payments cannot be transferred to another individual, other program, or other school year.

<b>Registration Fee</b> (non-refundable*)	<b>\$550</b>	Due by February 17. Includes the technology fee. Paid when the enrollment packet is submitted online.
<b>High School Retreat</b>	<b>\$350</b>	Grade 9–12 only
<b>Annual Tuition</b> (non-refundable*)	<b>\$33,700</b>	<p>Due in full by May 1 or a late fee of \$500 will be charged each month.</p> <p>Includes textbooks, international college advising, medical insurance, most on-campus testing.</p>
<b>Homestay</b>	<b>\$25,000</b>	<p>Due by May 1.</p> <p>Host families are available only to students 14 years or older. Junior high students may live with an approved family member. Elementary school students are required to live with at least one parent. All homestay applicants must complete an FCS Homestay Student Application and an FCS Homestay Permission for Care and Release form.</p> <p>Includes room and board, and transportation to and from all school events.</p>
